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MESSAGE FROM EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR



In 2019, Carlos Gabriel (age 11) together with Joan Gualberto and Roberto Cordero Palacios from the Laureles Chiapas School designed an app called EducaGame to teach other children in an entertaining way how to save, invest and venture. Maria de Jesus and Bernardo Zadquiel (age 9) from the Maka Weiner Association in Iztapalapa, Mexico City, set actions in motion to raise awareness in their community about the need to stop using plastic bags. Jose Luis and Diana Jornada (age 10) from Gota de Leche, also in Mexico City, built energy-saving lamps intended to, in their words, “provide society with an accessory that enables saving energy and, when sold, provide an income for the project.” At Jalpan de Serra, Queretaro, at Niños y Niñas de la Sierra, Victoria and Julieta participate in a project that aims to revolutionize chicken farming to supply organic eggs to their community.

EDUCA is continuously witnessing how girls, boys and adolescents from RED EDUCA are putting forth projects to make a difference in their schools and communities. We are convinced that among the more than 17 thousand students we supported in 2019, a Malala Yousafzai could emerge, Nobel Prize Winner for fighting for girls’ right to education, or a Mexican version of Greta Thunberg, who has encouraged millions of people around the world to demand their right to reverse global warming.

Our work for 24 years has focused on strengthening the work carried out by RED EDUCA schools, so more students like Carlos Gabriel, Victoria, Jose Luis and Diana can become agents of change and help us turn our country into a more equitable place where everyone enjoys the same opportunities for development, wellbeing, happiness and fulfillment. We only need to encourage and support them, to make their dreams come true!

This report is a summary of the activities conducted in 2019 but, above all, is a sample of what can be achieved through civil societies’ collaboration supported by the private sector. None of what is contained in this document would have been possible without the enthusiasm and commitment of directors, teachers, fundraisers and government bodies at the RED EDUCA schools, who directly work every day with our mission’s *raison d’être*. The work of EDUCA and RED EDUCA would not exist without the support of companies and recurring donors who, by investing their resources, time and talent into EDUCA, contribute to make a difference in the lives of the students we serve. Thanks to the alliances we have established with other national and international organizations, EDUCA grew and remained at the forefront of the topics we address.

For EDUCA, 2019 was a very good year. We learned that through perseverance, discipline and passion for what we do, good results can be reached. 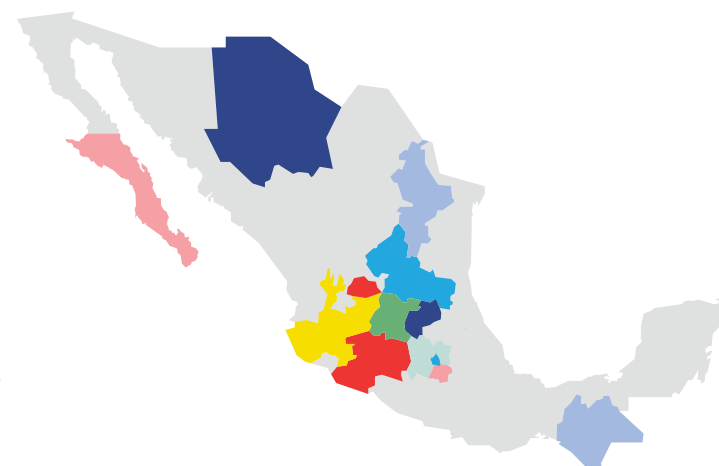

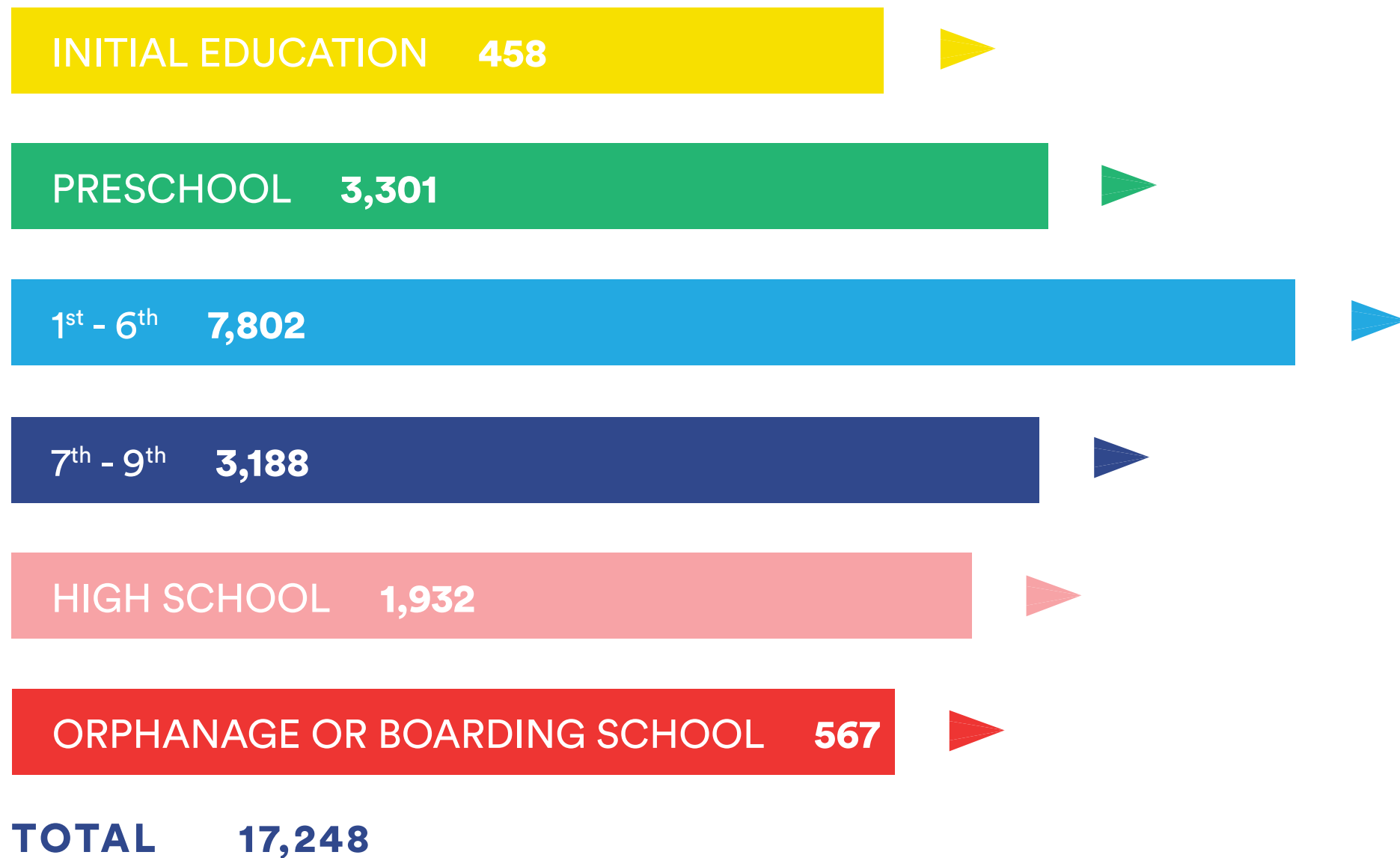

DISTRIBUTION OF GIRLS, BOYS AND TEENAGERS BY SCHOOL YEAR



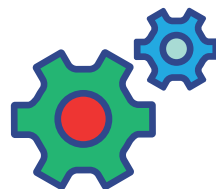

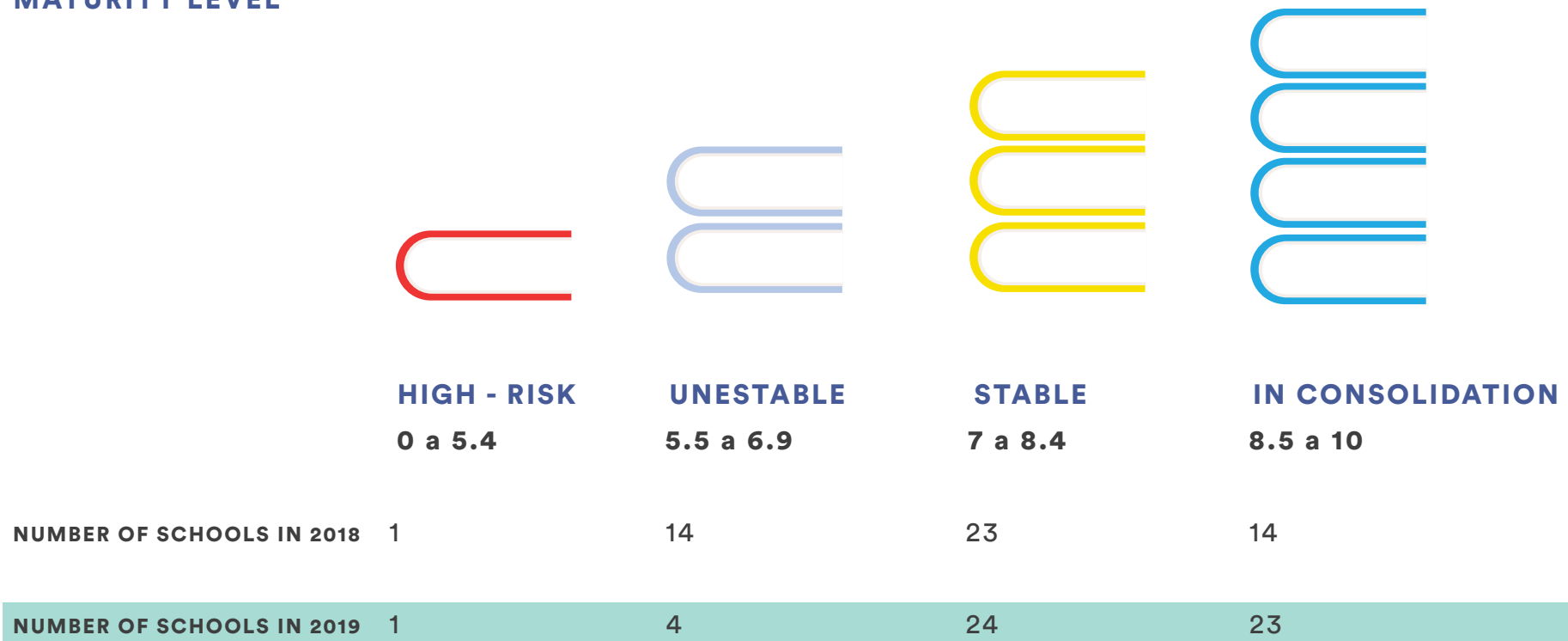


EDUCA MODEL

Drives continuous improvement of schools in RED EDUCA to reach their consolidation and become a quality benchmark, particularly in the 3 strategic axes: Institutional Strengthening, Education Quality and Sustainable Life.

Every year, institutions conduct an Institutional Self-diagnosis on our platform (156 indicators). The grade obtained (0 - 10) positions them on a scale that reflects their institutional maturity, while also showing RED EDUCA's average. Once we know where they stand, we implement actions through an Improvement Plan that contributes to better their grade, such as coaching and programs.

CUSTOMIZED COACHING

WE OFFERED THREE TYPES OF COACHING:

1. Organizational.
2. Fundraising.
3. Educational, provided by Instituto Mexicano para la Excelencia Educativa, A.C.

THE COACH PROMOTES:

- Development of leadership, communication, organization and decision-making skills.
- Analysis of Institutional Self-diagnosis results.
- Design of Improvement Plan.
- Definition of strategies for reaching goals.
- Training on specialized topics.
- Evaluation of results.

ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED

- 145 hours of counseling by an organizational coach for 8 schools to improve the indicators of the Government Body, Legal Framework and Human Resources Management.
- 107 hours of counseling by a fundraising coach for 7 schools to improve Administration, Finance and Fundraising indicators.
- 198 hours of counseling by an education coach for 15 schools to improve Education Model, Evaluation and Education Quality indicators.
- Thanks to the collaboration with Procura, A.C., 4 schools began accompaniment work with a coach focused on creating spaces for reflection, self-evaluation and participative planning that involves directors, teachers and parents.





RESULTS

Schools improved their results compared to the prior year: 90% reached a Stable or In Consolidation maturity level. Likewise, the RED EDUCA average was raised, from 7.86 to 8.17. Also,

100% of coached schools improved at least 2 of the indicators included in their Improvement Plan.

PROGRAMS



INSTITUTIONAL STRENGTHENING PROGRAM

Seeks to generate and grow a recurring minor donations flow through credit and debit cards that enable mitigating their cash flow issues and lack of school financing, intended to contribute

and guarantee their operative expenses and maintenance of education services.

ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED

- DONA&EDUCA Campaign for schools to increase their recurring donations base. 25 participating institutions.
- Fundraising and Online Strategy workshops for CSOs, 16 hours, aimed at fundraisers to strengthen their recruitment of recurring donations by optimizing their social media. 15 fundraisers from 9 institutions participated.
- Training seminar for designing social projects by using the Logical Framework Approach, aimed at directors and fundraisers, designed for strengthening their resource mobilization skills. 17 directors and fundraisers from 8 institutions participated.
- Institutional Projects Database. Summoned by inviting RED EDUCA schools to present a project linked to the results of their Institutional Self-diagnosis and aimed at improving EDUCA Model indicators.





RESULTS

■ **\$163,116** in new recurring donations collected by schools.

■ **\$626,00** in Incentive Donations delivered to the 15 schools that reached their goals.

■ From the Project Database, 2 institutions received **\$70,000** each, 2 institutions received **\$35,000** and 3 institutions received **\$50,000** each to strengthen their education projects:

Líderes del Siglo, A.C. to promote artistic and athletic skills by equipping the music studio and volleyball academy.

Centro Comunitario Teresiano. A.C. to promote the students' use of Computer and Communication Technologies.

Instituto María Isabel Dondé, I.A.P. Filial Pedro Poveda Funddé. to strengthen parents' educational role.

Centro Educativo La Buena Tierra, A.C. invested in equipping the school's kitchen to serve breakfast, lunch and dinner daily.



Gota de Leche, A.C. to implement a project through which students establish respectful, empathic, fair, intercultural and nondiscriminatory relationships with students from other federative entities in the country.

Instituto de Educación Integral, I.A.P. San Juan Pablo II. invested in high-performance sports classes.

Emotional Training Center, LFH, A.C. invested in standardizing the school methodology used on the education platform inside and outside the school.






PROGRAMS



SAVE AND VENTURE PROGRAM

This program seeks to transform the girls, boys and teenagers of RED EDUCA into agents of change by strengthening individual identity and a responsible exercise of their economic and social rights, thus improving their quality of life.

ACTIVITIES PERFORMED

- 35 hours of classes per school
- 1,581 books delivered for 1st to 4th grades and 1,790 student guides delivered for 5th grade to high school.
- 124 trained teachers and coordinators: 8 hours of initial training in person and 135 hours of guidance and monitoring on 2 follow-up visits at each school.
- The program's coordinator attended the International Aflatoun Training conducted in Quito, Ecuador, lasting 40 hours, on the study plan, Aflateen + Tools for Life and Financial Education, which offers a gender and sexuality focus with a health and reproductive rights element.
- EDUCA participated as a panel member at the International Aflatoun Conference conducted in Amsterdam, sharing the program implementation experience, particularly on the scope of Ventures conducted by teenagers, as a success story in the Americas.
- To celebrate the Aflatoun Day 2019, students from Niños y Niñas de la Sierra, I.A.P., and Instituto de Educación Integral, I.A.P. San Juan Pablo II Plantel Jurica, communicated via Skype with children and teenagers of Children International Ecuador, and schools in Colombia and El Salvador.
- 105 children and 12 teachers from 3 schools visited the Interactive Economy Museum (MIDE).
- We updated and redesigned the materials for teachers and students. Creating 4 new materials: student guides, teacher guides (by school grade), teaching strategies catalog and generic guide.





RESULTS

In an evaluation conducted before and after the students learning test:

- 90%** knows self-esteem is the ability to love, respect and take care of oneself.
- 90%** knows that a trait is a characteristic that distinguishes you from others.
- 80%** knows that talent is the ability you have to do something with ease.
- 80%** knows that human rights are everyone's rights, regardless of age, religion and gender.
- 60%** knows that peace culture consists of the values, attitudes and behaviors that reject violence and prevent conflicts.
- 90%** knows how to take into account the needs of others as if these were your own.
- 90%** knows solidarity is when you consider the needs of others as if these were your own.
- 70%** talks and participates with their family regarding household expenses, are allowed to share their opinion about money issues and receive an explanation when unable to purchase something.
- 80%** knows that saving is setting aside part of the money.

- 90%** saves in a savings box.
- 50%** keeps a record of their savings.
- 70%** states that their mid-term goal is finishing their studies.



PROGRAMS



As part of the Program, we held the EDUCA Fair: Save and Venture, where 500 girls, boys and teenagers from 9 states in the country participated with 63 ventures from elementary to high school and one invited preschool.

ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED IN THE FAIR

VENTURE CONTEST

To encourage girls, boys and teenagers to broadcast the ventures that show their teamwork skills, enhance social and environmental awareness, and empowerment to generate creative solutions that help improve our world.

ALQUILAB

Venture incubator to provide an array of support for entrepreneurial girls, boys and teenagers with consolidated projects that are seeking specialized counseling or resources to continue their projects.

GATHERING OF GIRLS, BOYS AND TEENAGERS

With the purpose of creating a space for the participation of empowered girls, boys and teenagers to debate on relevant topics of their current dynamics and their future: 1. Savings and investments; 2. Entrepreneurship and job opportunities; and, 3. Planning and life project.



SIMULTANEOUS WORKSHOPS FOR STUDENTS, TEACHERS AND PARENTS

To promote the strengthening of social and financial education competence, as well as the program's transversal topics, such as Peace Culture, Sustainable Development, Gender Equality and others.

STANDARD EVALUATION OF TEACHING SKILLS.

For the second year in a row, we conducted an evaluation distinguishing education levels (Preschool, 1st – 6th grades, 7th – 9th grades and High School) and divided into 4 sections: general knowledge, math, Spanish and financial education. The evaluation was conducted anonymously, but the tool was numbered, thus allowing each teacher to follow-up on results, which were published on the EDUCA website with performance data for each participant and suggestions for improvement.

As a strategy to strengthen the logical-mathematical and reading skills of teachers as of the results of the evaluation at the Congress, 112 teachers from 13 schools participated in 33 training hours, divided into 6 math and reading workshops given in Mexico City, State of Mexico and Morelos. This project performed:

- Mid-term evaluation
- Logical-mathematical thinking workshops
- Teachers follow-up and accompaniment
- Final evaluation



RESULTS

- The average per school increased slightly over half a point from the mid-term to the final evaluations.
- 9 schools raised their average in math and 10 schools increased their average in Spanish.
- The number of teachers who had good or very good results increased from one evaluation to the other, both in Math and Spanish.
- Teachers who had a very poor to regular level improved their performance, both in Math and Spanish.
- Spelling and vocabulary showed a significant improvement.






EDUCA MATH FOR STUDENTS

Through Matematiké, a methodology shared by Escuela Bernardo Grousset, A.C., which strengthens the imagination, intelligence and creativity to contextualize, understand, prove, apply and evaluate concepts in arithmetic, geometry and algebra at different levels of abstraction, students from the SEDAC, I.A.P. elementary school improved their performance in math.

ACTIVITIES PERFORMED

- 13 teachers and 2 coordinators received 9 hours of training on content and methodology.
- 9 teachers participated in a 48-hour specialized certification course to implement the program.
- 442 textbooks and workbooks were delivered to students in the 3rd grade of preschool and 1st to 3rd grades of elementary school.
- We conducted 26 hours of follow-up visits and classroom accompaniment.
- Evaluation of students' learning with different indicators for each school grade.

47% recognizes the representation of a fraction.

77% recognizes addition as the inverse of subtraction.

76% recognizes subtraction as the inverse of addition.

2° ELEMENTARY

95.3% identifies predecessors and successors in hundreds.

36% solves addition problems up to tens.

88% subtracts with a higher degree of complexity (subtracting without carrying over in two-digit amounts).

38% subtracts with carrying over three-digit amounts with two-digit amounts.

79% represents an addition in elaborate notation.

52% represents a subtraction in elaborate notation.

83% multiplies a one-digit number with a two-digit number (carrying over).

3° ELEMENTARY

100% completes successions with varying degrees of complexity.

74% multiplies 1 digit by 1 digit; **71%** multiplies 2 digits by 1 digit without carry over; **48%** multiplies 2 digits by 1 digit with carry over.

42% multiplies 3 digits by 1 digit with carry over; **20%** multiplies 3 digits by 1 digit without carrying over; and **10%** multiplies 3 digits by 2 digits with carry over.

96% writes a number up to hundreds.

92% writes a number up to thousands.

98% identifies a visual representation of a fraction.

CREATING CODE

Through an alliance with Fundación Telefónica México, we established this project with the purpose of training teachers on skills for the 21st century through technology. The project was implemented in two stages.




In **Stage 1**, training focused on 5 courses: Introduction to ABP, How to establish Creating Code in your classroom, Scratch, Programming by blocks and Gamify your project.

In **Stage 2**, training was expanded to 22 courses, including those from stage 1: communication and collaboration, turn your students into Booktubers, content creation, creativity and innovation, augmented and virtual reality in your classroom, Scratch and App Inventor, advanced programming, practical applications with Makey Makey, HTML5 and JavaScript, programming in code, 3D printing, technology instruments of robotics, and others.



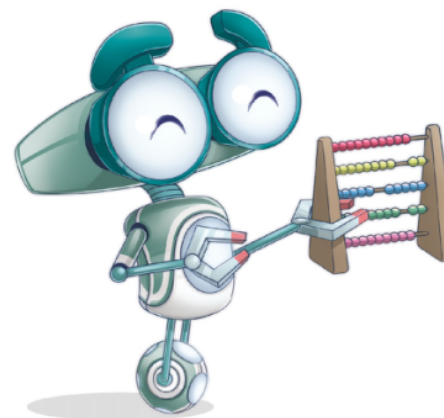

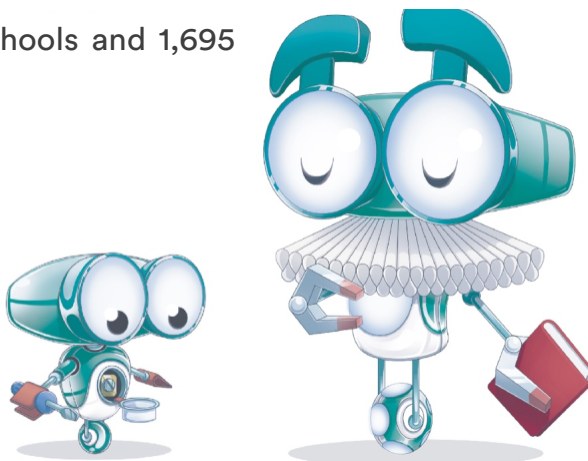

In representation of WEE, we attended the blue area of COP25 (United Nations Climate Change Conference), held in Madrid on December 2019, to promote our initiative and drive a global education agreement for all schools to incorporate environmental education into their school curriculum.

Furthermore, we participated in high level meetings with the Ministry of Public Education, the Ministry of the Environment and Natural Resources, and the Office of the Presidency of the Mexican Government responsible for the 2030 Agenda, as well as international bodies and diplomats from various countries, such as Italy, Qatar, India, Colombia and Chile to promote the initiative.

Aflatoun is a global organization present in 100 countries and reaching a benefitted population of 5.4 million girls, boys and teenagers.

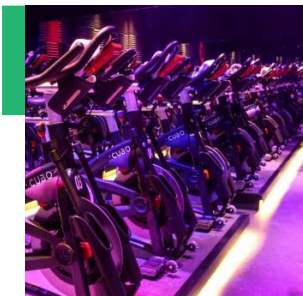

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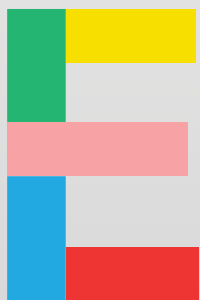


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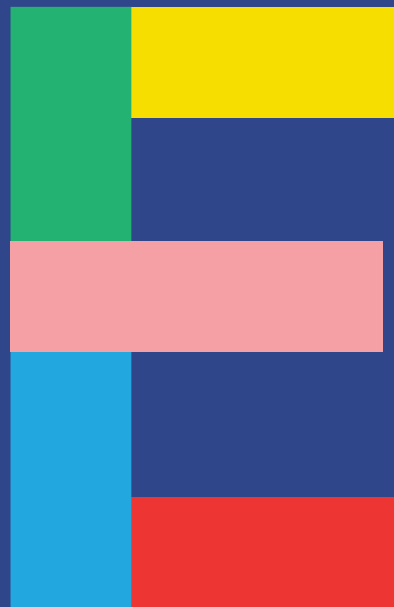
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
